

Koslowski, Holy Cross Grid Star, Wins State Amateur Golf Crown

**21-Year-Old All-American Footballer Defeats
Charlie Morrill of Massasoit, 6 and 4, on Paw-
tucket Course by Flashy, Consistent Play**

By combining streaks of remarkable consistency with flashy, scrambling efficiency while his opponent was enduring harrowing putting experiences, Stan Koslowski 21-year-old host club star, ascended to the Rhode Island Amateur golf throne yesterday by defeating Charlie Morrill of Massasoit, 6 and 4, at the Pawtucket Golf Club.

That performance—one over par for the 14 holes required in the afternoon section of their 36-hole title duel—brought the former caddy, schoolboy and junior champion to the amateur pinnacle in his first quest for the crown. The demands of college and armed services had kept the erstwhile Holy Cross All-America footballer out of serious golf com-

petition the past few years and the approaching All-Star game, as well as his professional football commitments with the Miami Seahawks very nearly deprived him of the opportunity to compete in this tournament.

But, given the chance, he made the most of it. He won the medal on Monday, played consistently in the low 70's in his matches—once dipping well below par—and yesterday climaxed four days of personal triumphs by his convincing triumph over an able opponent.

After finishing the morning round all even, thanks in the late stages to erratic short work by Morrill, and dividing the first two holes in the
