Notice to Competitors/Local Rules - Agawam Hunt

Tee Markers – All play will be from White Tee Markers

<u>All French drains</u> throughout the course are obstructions.

Newly Seeded Areas: A newly seeded area is deemed to be ground under repair whether or not so marked.

<u>Sod Seams:</u> If a player's ball lies in or touches a seam of cut turf or a seam interferes with the player's area of intended swing: (a) Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. (b) Ball on Putting Green. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1d. <u>But interference does not exist if the seam only interferes with the player's stance.</u>

<u>Cart path extensions</u>: Areas not marked, which are extensions of cart paths are deemed to be part of the path. Fellow competitors must be notified before taking relief.

<u>Flower beds and ornamental planting areas</u>: Treat as obstructions. Flower beds within paved areas are considered part of the obstruction.

<u>Course Boundary</u>: Holes 1,2,7,8,9,10, 12, 14 and 15 are indicated by fence poles or post. Hole's 16 & 18 white line and white stakes behind green extending to edge of Pro Shop. Parking lot and Maintenance Building are OB.

<u>Hole 12</u>: Dump area left drive zone in woods. The ball must be found and lying in or on a pile of material or pile must interfere with stance or swing. Relief is nearest point plus one club length away from edge of the pile of material.

<u>Play-off</u>: In the event of a tie at the conclusion of scheduled play, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off to determine the winner.
