**Notice to Competitors / LOCAL RULES-Triggs Memorial GC**

**Tees:** All play will be from the **WHITE** Tee Markers

**French Drains:** are to be treated as obstructions; proceed under Rule 16.1.

**Flower beds and ornamental planting areas:** are to be treated as ground under repair. Ornamental plantings within paved areas are considered part of the obstruction.

**Newly Seeded Areas:** A newly seeded area is deemed to be ground under repair whether or not so marked. A player must ask a fellow competitor before taking relief.

**Cart Path extensions:** (entrances and exits only) are deemed to be part of the obstruction. Player must check with fellow competitor before taking relief.

**Golf Course Boundaries:** Stone walls on holes 1, 2, 9. Ball is considered Out of Bounds when it comes to rest over the wall. White painted line behind 9 green. Fence's on holes 3, 6, 11, 14, 15, & 16. Inside edge of fence posts at ground level are deemed to be the boundary.

**Hole #1:** "Pump House" – Relief for swing and stance interference only.

**Hole #14:** Area behind and right of green is a penalty. You must be virtually certain that your ball has entered the penalty area in order to proceed under Rule 17. A Drop Zone has been added as an additional option behind the 15<sup>th</sup> tee.

**Hole # 15:** Area in front of tee is deemed to be part of the general area.

**Playoff:** If event of a tie, there will be a sudden death playoff after the completion of scheduled play.
