Notice to Competitors/Local Rules - Valley CC

Tee Markers: All play is from Red TEE MARKERS.

<u>French Drains</u>: All French Drains are to be treated as obstructions.

<u>Driving Range:</u> is part of the General Area.

<u>Surface rocks in closely mown areas</u>: May be treated as obstructions from interference when playing from your own fairway only.

Newly Seeded Areas: A newly seeded area is deemed to be ground under repair whether or not so marked. A player must ask a fellow competitor before taking relief.

<u>Drop Zone Hole #12 & #17</u>: A drop zone is available on holes #12 & 17 near forward tee as an additional option for ball that comes to rest in the penalty area. See Rule 17.

<u>Boundary Hole #9</u>: Edge of asphalt road (golf course side) beyond wall is deemed to be boundary along right side of hole. Stone wall is deemed to be an integral object of the course. Boundary continues beyond green with white stakes.

Integral Objects of the Course: Stone walls on holes #9, 10, & 18.

<u>Out of Bounds</u>: Indicated by white stakes, fence posts, metal fence poles, and walls. When stone walls are employed a ball is out of bounds when it comes to rest over the wall.

Flower beds and ornamental: Plantings within paved areas are considered part of the obstruction.

<u>Playoff:</u> In the event of a tie after 18 holes for the overall winner there will be a sudden death playoff immediately following play.
