Notice to Competitors/Local Rules – Cranston CC

Tees: All play will be from White Markers.

Flower beds and ornamental planting areas: are to be treated as ground under repair. Ornamental plantings within paved areas are considered part of the obstruction.

<u>French Drains/Surface Rocks in Closely Mown Areas</u>: are to be treated as obstructions. Proceed under Rule 16.

<u>Cart Path extensions</u>: (entrances and exits only) are deemed to be part of the obstruction. Player must check with fellow competitor before taking relief.

<u>Aeration Holes</u>: If a player's ball lies in or touches an aeration hole: (a) Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. If the ball comes to rest in another aeration hole the player may take relief again under this Local Rule. (b) Ball on Putting Green. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1d.

But interference does not exist if the aeration hole only interferes with the player's stance or, on the putting green, on the player's line of play.

Newly Seeded Areas: A newly seeded area is deemed to be ground under repair, whether or not it is marked.

<u>Permanent elevated power lines and cables</u>: For a ball that strikes an elevated power line, cable, pole or metal tower, the stroke must be cancelled and replayed without penalty. If the ball is not immediately recoverable another ball may be substituted.

Drop Zones: **Hole #8**: As an additional option under Rule 17.1, a drop zone has been added right of tee. **Hole #9**: For a ball that comes to rest on cart path right of green a drop zone has been added as an additional option.

Stonewalls: For Holes #2, 3, 6, 7, 14 & 16: are deemed to be integral objects of the course.

<u>**Out of Bounds</u>**: Defined by white stakes and painted white line on Holes 1 & 2. Stone walls on Holes 5, 10 and 11.</u>

Playoff: In the event of a tie after 36 Holes, there will be a sudden death playoff immediately following play.
