Notice to Competitors/Local Rules - Kirkbrae CC

Tees: Red Tees

<u>French Drains/Surface Rocks in Closely Mown Areas</u>: Are to be treated as obstructions; proceed under Rule 16.

<u>Flower beds and ornamental planting areas</u>: are to be treated as ground under repair. Ornamental plantings within paved areas are considered part of the obstruction. Mulch around trees and bushes is **not** considered ground under repair. Mulch is a loose impediment.

<u>Hole #8</u>: Driving range is *part of the General Area*; DROP ZONE provided as an additional option for Rule 16 (Obstructions). Additional relief provided for line of play intervention from netting, poles and cables. **Drop Zone may also be used as an additional option for Rule 19 (Ball Unplayable).**

<u>Hole #12</u>: Drop Zone may also be used for additional option for Rule 17 (Penalty Area). If a ball crosses penalty area at a point further from the hole than where the drop zone is located, drop zone cannot be used as an additional option.

Hole #17: **Nursery Area**- To be treated as a wrong putting green.

<u>Course Boundary:</u> White Stakes: Inside edge of stake is deemed to be the boundary on holes 4, 6, 8, 9, 13, 14, & 18. Chain link/Wooden fence: Inside edge of fence is deemed to be boundary on hole 8 & 9. Hole #17: White dots and stone wall. <u>Hole #18</u>: After last O.B. stake left, the parking lot is deemed to be the course boundary.

<u>Playoff:</u> In the event of a tie after 18 holes, there will be a sudden death playoff immediately following play.
