Posting Scores Moves into the Mobile Age

As you begin to golf this season and post scores you'll notice a new look in every pro-shop – the USGA's GHIN (golf handicap information network) department has developed the latest version of GHIN score posting as a completely web-based product. The look and feel of the new system will be different, but the process of posting will remain the same. The new score entry screen will function as the old software-based product did, but with added features that will communicate with GHIN members more easily. Added features will allow the golf association to post and update information and push information to pro-shop computers with the touch of a few buttons.

A new feature of the system is the ability to search for clubs when a golfer plays away from home. If you play in Florida or the Carolinas this spring you'll search first by state, and then by typing the first few letters of the club you've played. A listing of clubs in the state will appear. Selecting a club will then allow you to see all tees that have a course rating. The process to post a score will be no different than posting at your home club.

Why a new web-based system

The process of transmitting scores in the old software was problematic. If a club's computer didn't transmit on a regular basis some issues occurred during the next revision date. If a transmission didn't take place on the 1st or 15th of the month some issues arose regarding whether a player's handicap index was correct. With the new web-based product a player's score will be posted immediately to the GHIN server, eliminating any transmission errors. On the two revisions each month, handicap indexes will be calculated and then available in the system immediately. The ability of the USGA to host, store and



backup every GHIN member's information in one database will stabilize the system moving forward.

Another great feature of the new system is the ability of the RIGA to assist clubs if a potential issue occurs. If a member is having a problem with score posting or the club is having issues with the system, the golf association now has the ability to remotely log into the clubs' computer and fix a potential problem. With every golf club in Rhode Island using a high-speed internet connection, all will be converted to the new system before score posting begins on April 1st. Golfers will notice that the first time they post a score this season a prompt will appear to add or verify their email address. This will allow the USGA to send out handicap indexes via email on the 1st & 15th of the month.

Moving to a web-based product now also gives the golf professionals and handicap chairs the ability to update and maintain the clubs database remotely. Maintaining the system doesn't need to happen at

the club's pro-shop computer; working at home is now an option to avoid distractions in the golf shop.

In the palm of your hand

The RIGA is also proud to announce a new GHIN mobile app. The GHIN mobile app is another product the GHIN department has designed for the golf association to assist members in posting and finding information more easily via a smart phone. You can download the app through the APP Store or Market on your smart phone by search for "GHIN mobile app". Once the app is downloaded your GHIN number and last name will personalize the app to your score history. Some features of the GHIN mobile app allow a golfer to search which courses they play on a regular basis, which courses they score best or worst on, and a history of tees you have played.

These products and new features will make posting scores much easier, as well as facilitate finding information about your golf game.

As the RIGA prepares for its 111th golf season I would like to thank everyone involved who helped and supported the association during the 2012

season - member clubs, their boards, golf pros, superintendents, support staff, members, volunteers and players. The RIGA had a successful year and contributed \$240,000 back to its member clubs.

I would like to congratulate the 2012 RIGA champions and all who participated in one or more events. The season had a few exciting highlights which included Charlie Blanchard winning the Amateur Championship for a second time, Brad Valois finishing 3rd in the Rhode Island Open and breaking the course record at Ledgemont in the 1st round shooting 63. Bobby Leopold made it to the round of 16 in the US Amateur for the second year in a row. The three player's mentioned above also played in the USGA Mid-Amateur with

Blanchard defeating Valois in and the Player of the Year coming down to the final event of the season with Leopold edging out Charlie Blanchard by 17 points.

The 2013 championship calendar will again be a great one, with Quidnessett hosting the 108th Amateur Championship in July, Alpine hosting the RI Open in August and Agawam Hunt will host the Junior Amateur which will have a girls division for the first time in RIGA history. The RIGA Weekly Invitational packages are a great option for members of RIGA member clubs. If you have never played in a weekly invitational a complete listing of the weeklies and how to register is located within this newsletter.

As we move through the golf season this year there is a chance you will hear about the RIGA and the RIWGA merging into one golf association. Both groups have been in discussion over the winter months and committees have been formed to evaluate the possibility of a merger. A public informational meeting will be held sometime in April. Once a date is locked in information will be posted and emailed to all golfers and golf clubs in Rhode Island.

I would like to thank the RIGA member clubs and its members for their continued support of the Burke Fund and Button Hole. Along with the bag tag program that most clubs support on an annual basis, these clubs go above and beyond to support additional programs. Carnegie Abbey, Newport, Shelter Harbor and Wampanoag continue to host the Burke gross and net each year. RICC hosted an event to support the Burke Fund last Fall, Lincoln CC runs a memorial in Fran Reavey's name at Triggs and all contributions are donated to the Burke Fund. Point Judith hosted an event to support Button Hole last summer and Wannamoisett members continued the traditional Turkey Trot tournament at Button Hole which supports families of Button Hole kids during Thanksgiving. Lady members from Triggs, Glocester, Ledgemont, Quidnessett, the RIWGA and OSWGA have also run events and contributed to Button Hole.

I again am looking forward to an exciting season of golf in Rhode Island. Happy New Year hope to see you all at a course sometime soon. ↑

2013 Weekly Invitational Packages

Registration for the 2013 RIGA Weekly Invationals will be the same process as it has in recent years.

The program is open to all members of a RIGA member club and players are required to sign up as a foursome. The designated captain will be the contact for each group. Captains are asked to ensure that each player join the RIGA member program before the first event. When completing the registration form please include the email address of each player in the group. This will help with communication in the event something changes for a given weekly.

The only applications that will be considered are those that arrive via U.S. Postal Service Mail postmarked no earlier than **March 5th**. Tee times will range from 7:30-12:30. If early groups cannot keep pace the RIGA reserves the right to assign that group a later time.

The Stableford scoring system will again be used in an effort to speed up play for each round. The top 15 players, the highest point totals, from each round will accumulate points toward the Weekly Net Championship (October 15 – Quidnessett CC). Again, players will collect points for each hole with a net double bogey being the limit. Gift certificates for each weekly will be distributed by GROSS Stableford points within your handicap division. Points for the Weekly Net Championship will still be the top 15 NET Stableford point totals for each weekly. To be eligible for the Weekly Net Championship a player must turn in a card for four of the six weeklies. Players are not obligated to participate in the “point’s race”, but may choose to play in the weekly program on a noncompetitive basis.

Groups need to check in with the RIGA representative when ready to play. Any substitute players need to be changed so accurate scoring can take place. All scorecards should be turned into the golf shop once play is complete. The RIGA will again be posting all scores to the GHIN system.

The fee to participate in the Weekly Invitational program packages for 2013 will be \$1440.00 per package or \$360.00 per player and includes cart fees for each event. Credit cards will again be accepted as a form of payment, Visa or MasterCard only. Please complete the registration form completely if a credit card is used as the form of payment. If a Group would like to participate in multiple packages please indicate in the check box located on the bottom of the registration form. Packages are distributed on a first come first serve basis and multiple packages will be given out once everyone participating gets one package. The sign-up period will begin on Tuesday, **March 5th**. Any mail postmarked prior to **March 5th** will be returned. No USPS Express Mail will be accepted that was initiated prior to **March 5th**. “Walk-ins” to the RIGA office are NOT permitted. The RIGA office will inform the captains by mail & e-mail in late March. |
