Notice to Competitors/Local Rules - WANUMETONOMY G&CC

Tees: All play will be from the **WHITE** tee markers.

Flower beds and ornamental planting areas: are to be treated as ground under repair. Ornamental plantings within paved areas are considered part of the obstruction.

French Drains: are to be treated as obstructions; proceed under Rule 16.

Supporting Guy Wires on Holes # 6&10: Wires are deemed to be an obstruction. Relief is provided for area of intended swing, stance, lie of ball and on the line of play.

Boundary: **Holes #1, 2, 5, 8, 10, 11, 12 & 13**- White Stakes. **Holes #6&7** - Chain link fence poles. **Holes #9&10**- Patio, clubhouse and parking lot are out of bounds. **Hole #10** – Wooden fence is boundary with stakes continuing boundary on either side.

Holes #2&8: For the play of these two holes, players may utilize the opposite side of the penalty area under model local rule B-2.1 as a relief option. On hole 2, the penalty area down the left side and hole 8, it is the penalty area down the right side.

Sod Seams: If a player's ball lies in or touches a seam of cut turf or a seam interferes with the player's area of intended swing:

- (a) Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b.
- (b) Ball on Putting Green. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1d.

But interference does not exist if the seam only interferes with the player's stance.

Putting Green: Is deemed to be wrong putting green and relief must be taken under Rule 13.1f.

Playoff: Any tie for low gross after 36 holes will be decided by a sudden-death play-off to be held at the conclusion of play on Wednesday, October 11th. Starting on hole #1. All other ties will be determined by using the USGA recommended procedures, i.e. total back 9, total back 6, total back 3, etc.
